R56 Declarations of pecuniary or non-pecuniary interest – all Parish Councillors
present declared a non-pecuniary interest in The New Build

R58 The minutes of the last meeting having been circulated were agreed and signed –
proposed Councillor Buckton – seconded Councillor Tait

R59 Matters arising

A Child Welfare Officer for the Recreation Club was discussed – and agreed that each
club should appoint their own Child Welfare Officer.

R60 Clubs

Bowls: Maintenance: The Green had been scarified and spiked. Moss Control had
been carried out by Lawn Keeper. Fertiliser needed to be applied

A request was made for the cutting of hedges.

Cricket: Mr. G. Robb reported that the league AGM was due to be held and he
needed to know the availability of the ground for the next season and the provision of
changing facilities. Several options for changing facilities were discussed i.e. gazebo,
tent, caravan

Football: Mr. D. Hebblewhite told the meeting that he was leaving the Football Club –
but was leaving it in the hands of Gaz. Thanks were expressed to Mr. Hebblewhite for
his commitment to the Football Club

Tennis: Mrs. Sheard brought to the meeting 3 quotes for the resurfacing of the Tennis
Courts.

Allotments Land: Councillor Holmes and Wildridge updated the meeting on the
progress for the proposed allotments
