Rec 1 Apologies for absence received from Councillor Mr. R. Webster

Rec 2 All Councillors present declared a non-pecuniary interest in The New Build

Rec 3 Open Forum – No items

Rec 4 New Build

The Parish Councillors had a site visit to view the interior of the New Build with Mr. T. Stephenson from Stubbs Bros

Mr. G. Robb proposed that if possible the roof space in the garage could be made available for storage – Councillor Tait to enquire to Stubbs Bros

The opening date for the New Build will be 9 December 2017 – Councillor Martinson to collaborate the team to organise the opening

Signage internally and externally was discussed – liaise with Stubbs Bros

Access to Recreation Club – Councillor Wildridge proposed that no restrictions should be made to the access of the Recreation Club – but with traffic calming measures in place and a form of deterrent for vehicles to access the sports areas – seconded Councillor Carr

Councillor Tait proposed that Round Tables should be purchased for use in the Function Rooms – seconded Councillor Buckton.

Councillor Carr also proposed that some rectangular tables should also be purchased – seconded Councillor Tait

A smoking area/shelter was discussed – no decision

Councillor Martinson to make enquiries regarding costings for hiring out the function rooms at The New Build
